#### Simple Past Tense (Regular Verbs)

The simple past is a verb tense that's used to talk about things that happened or existed before now. **(El pasado simple es un tiempo verbal que se usa para hablar sobre cosas que sucedieron o existieron antes.)**

### How to Formulate the Simple Past

For regular verbs, add **-ed** to the root form of the verb (or just **-d** if the root form already ends in an e) **(Para verbos regulares, agregue -ed a la forma raíz del verbo (o simplemente -d si la forma raíz ya termina en una e)**

Play→Played Type→Typed Listen→Listened Push→Pushed Love→Loved

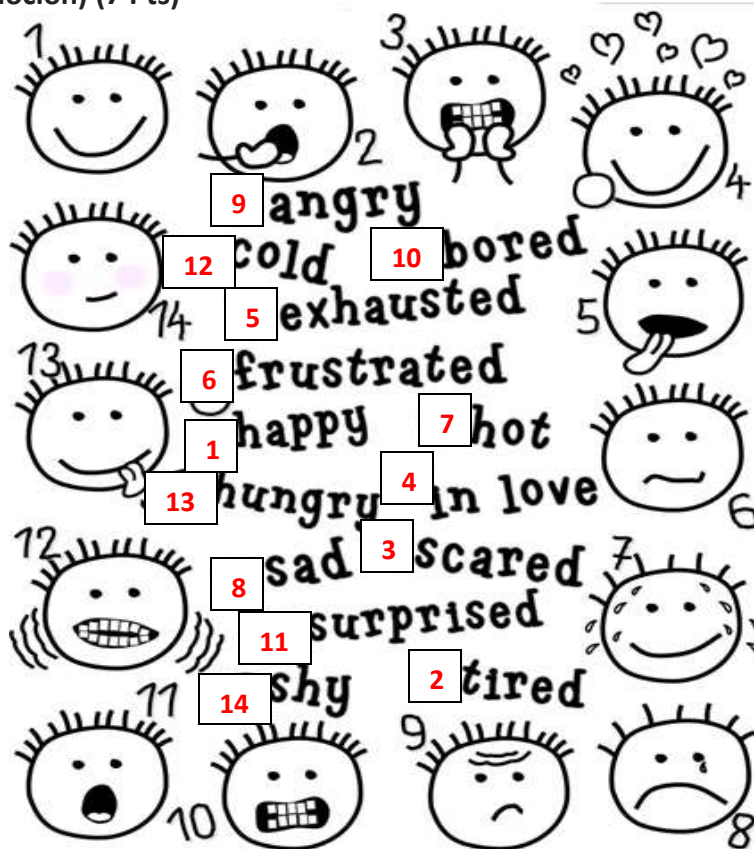

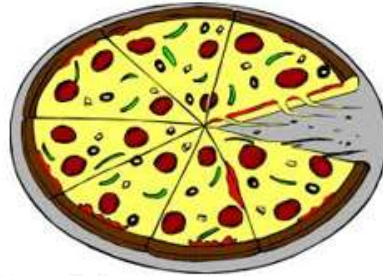
